Remote Access is a special feature which lets you access your **ClinicalKey** account from outside of PGIM network. Follow the instructions below to enable “Remote Access”

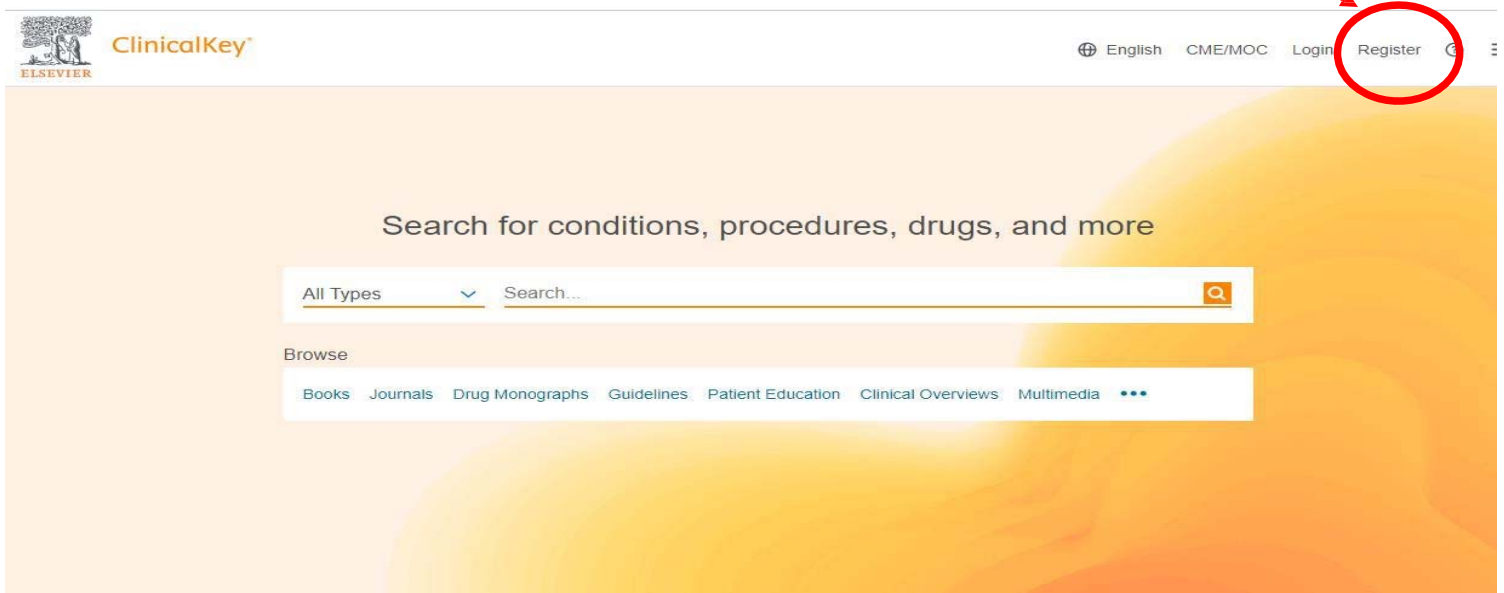

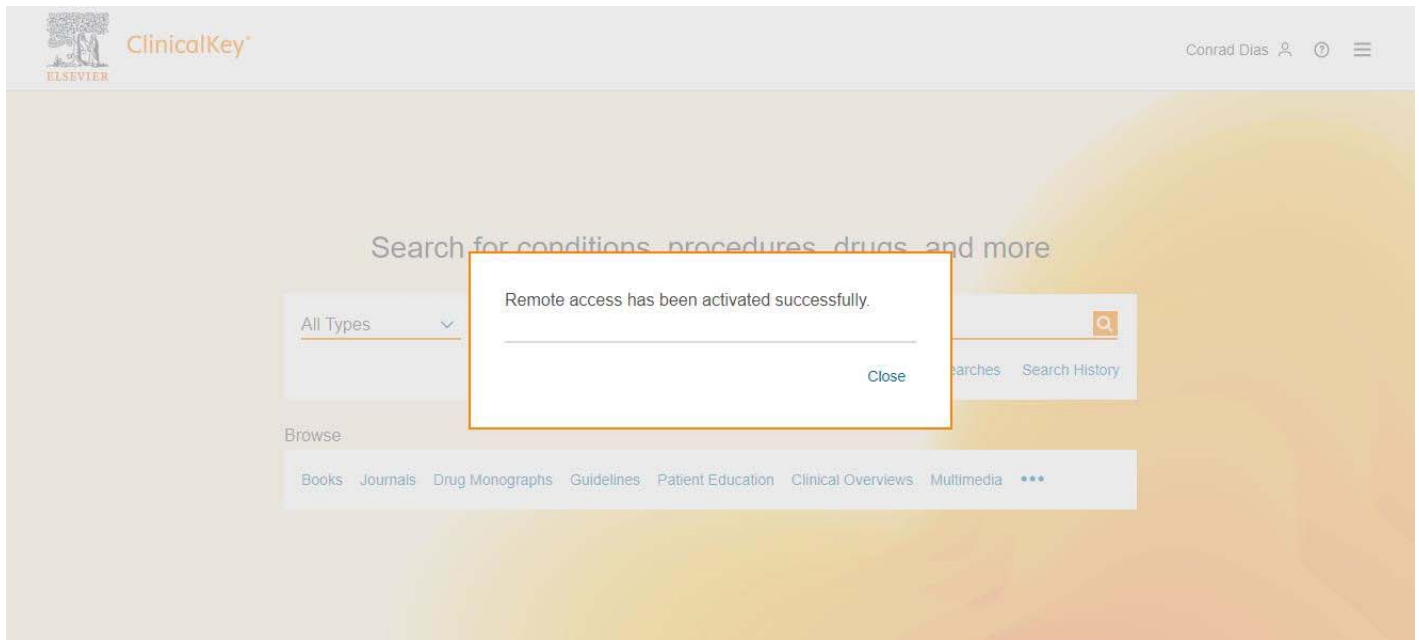

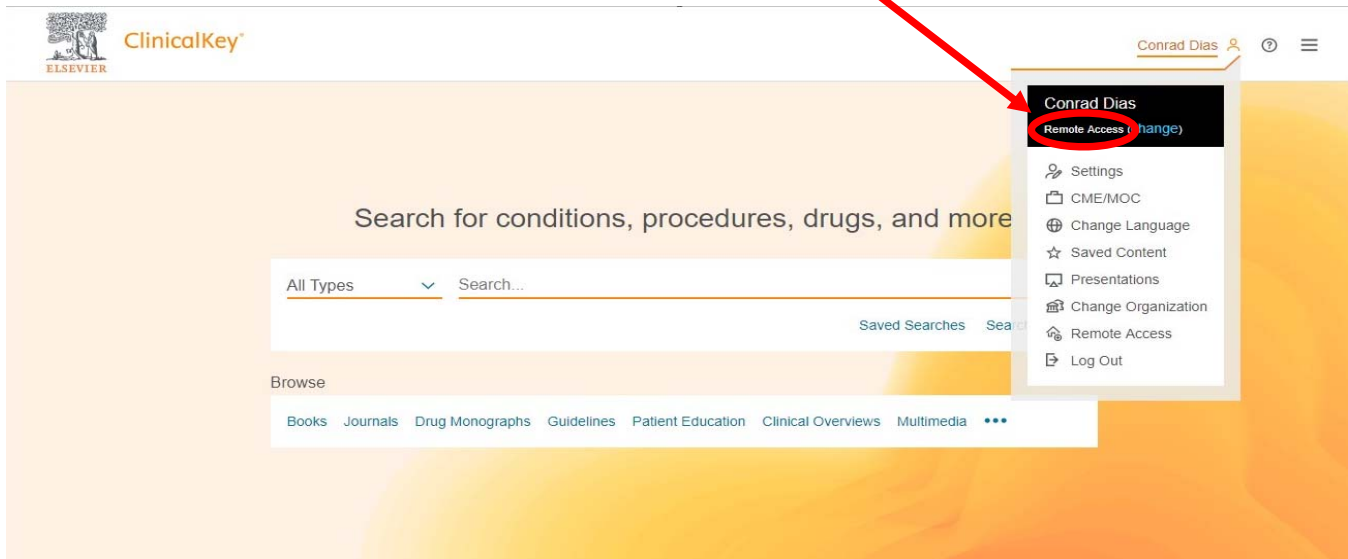
You need to click on the link provided in the email to enable Remote Access on your CLINICALKEY account.
