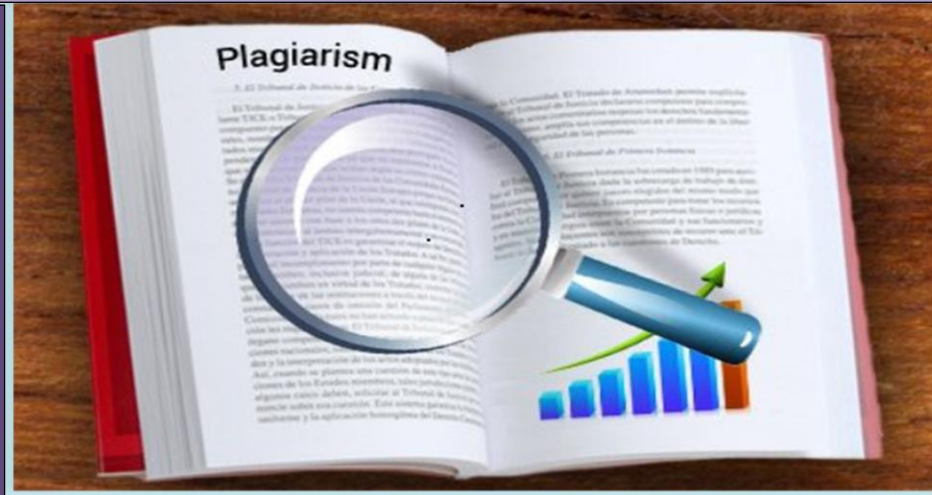


Webinar on How to Avoid Plagiarism

Plagiarism is presenting someone else's work or ideas as your own, with or without their consent, by incorporating it into your work without full acknowledgement. All published and unpublished material, whether in manuscript, printed or electronic form, is covered under this definition. Plagiarism may be intentional or reckless, or unintentional. In any form, plagiarism is a disciplinary offence and therefore as a scholar or as a trainee, one must take measures to avoid plagiarism.
